### Question:

I need the current release of software tools for my M4K module, for 32bit/64bit Windows (or some other operating system). I visited the Excalibur Systems website, and looked for the file to download.

What is the file naming convention ? So that I can decide which file(s) to download.

### Answer:

To navigate to the correct page on our website (shortcuts to various M4K module and other popular webpages), please see FAQ titled "**Website - Where can I find the files**".

Once you are at the desired webpage, please note the following naming conventions:

Acrobat files (with a red icon)	are manuals
<b>_hw</b>	for hardware manual
<b>_sw</b>	for software API manual
<b>hw-</b>	is the prefix for hardware installation disk (for the Device Manager)
<b>m4k-</b>	is the prefix for the specific M4K module type
<b>-st-</b>	is for software tools packages
<b>-st-win</b>	is for 32bit Windows software tools
<b>-st-winx64</b>	is for 64bit Windows software tools
<b>-st-win32-win64</b>	is combined software tools for 32bit and 64bit Windows
<b>-st-ln</b>	is software tools for 32bit Linux
<b>-st-ln64</b>	is software tools for 64bit Linux
<b>-vi-win</b>	is for LabVIEW tools
<b>-cvi-win</b>	is for LabWindows CVI tools
