Once you are at the desired webpage, please note the following naming conventions:

Acrobat files (with a red icon)	are manuals
_hw	for hardware manual
_sw	for software API manual
hw-	is the prefix for hardware installation disk (for the Device Manager)
m4k-	is the prefix for the specific M4K module type
-st-	is for software tools packages
-st-win	is for 32bit Windows software tools
-st-winx64	is for 64bit Windows software tools
-st-win32-win64	is combined software tools for 32bit and 64bit Windows
-st-In	is software tools for 32bit Linux
-st-ln64	is software tools for 64bit Linux
-vi-win	is for LabVIEW tools
-cvi-win	is for LabWindows CVI tools
